Year 1	Research one very hot and very cold country in the world.
	Draw and label a picture of the countries to show: the landscape, people,
	houses, weather and some animals.
Year 2	Where would you prefer to live Jersey or Africa? Why?
	Research a country like South Africa or Kenya and explain the climate, animals,
	different traditions etc.
	Note the geographical features of the country e.g. Mountains, rivers,
	rainforests.
	By the end of the research the children need to show evidence of what they
	have found and answer the initial question.
	This can be completed as a PowerPoint/Keynote presentation; create a
	poster; write an information book about it or present in another format that
	they have easy access to.
Year 3	Choose either Elizabeth Castle or Mont Orgueil Castle to research and produce
	a presentation about them, focusing on their features and how they were
	used in the past and how they are used today. This can be presented by either
	a poster, PowerPoint or in an alternative way.
Year 4	Research a city of your choice from any country. Create a fact file with
	interesting information.
Year 5	Research and create a detailed project about either Stonehenge or Skara Brae,
	two of the most well-known Neolithic sites in the UK. Stonehenge is a
	prehistoric monument in Wiltshire that took Neolithic builders an estimated
	1500 years to build. Skara Brae is a Neolithic village that was first discovered
	in 1850, when a great storm battered Orkney Islands and revealed the outline
	of a number of stone buildings.
Year 6	Find out about Charles Darwin and create a presentation.
	Create a family tree.
